5. Reports

OC/5.1/16.08 Waverley Development Control Plan - Amendment No. 5 (A15/0395)

MOTION / UNANIMOUS DECISION Mover: Cr Kay

That Council adopts the Draft Waverley Development Control Plan 2012 (Amendment No. 5), in accordance with Section 21 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000, subject to the following amendments to Attachment 1:

1. (page 57) Part B8 Section 8.1.1 control (f) is to be amended to state "Council may also require on-site parking provision to be reduced or removed for development fronting secondary streets or laneways in the Bondi Junction Centre to achieve the objectives of Part E1.4.2. The exact reduction in on-site parking provision will be determined by Council on a case-by-case basis. Developments that have a

single frontage to a primary street will not be permitted on-site parking."

- 2. (page 125) Part C1 Section 1.1.2 Figure 2 'How to calculate height on sloping land' is to be amended to remove any numerical controls.
- 3. (page 142) Part C1 Section 1.9 Solar Access controls are to be re-ordered and amended as follows:
 - i. Controls (b) and (c) become new controls (a) and (b), respectively.
 - ii. Control (a) becomes new control (c) and now reads: "Despite controls (a) & (b) above, where a variation to floor space ratio, maximum building height, maximum wall height or setbacks controls causes a reduction in direct sunlight to adjoining properties, *any* reduction may be considered unacceptable.
 - iii. Control (d) which currently reads "Solar impacts on adjoining properties are to be minimised, especially for east-west oriented blocks located to the south." is to be deleted, and control (e) becomes new control (d).
- 4. (page 148) Part C1 Section 1.11 Car Parking, 1.11.3 Design Control (f) is to be amended so that the last sentence of the control reads "If only one replacement tree is practicable in front of the subject site, the second replacement tree is to be planted preferably in another Council determined location in the street, or on the site itself."
- 5. (page 181) Part C2 Section 2.9, the second paragraph of the introductory text is to be amended as follows:
 - "An attic is a top level extension of floor area within a pitched roof section of an existing or newly proposed building envelope, being ancillary to the main form of the building (refer to Figure 23).
- 6. (page 181) Part C2 Section 2.9, Control (c) is to be amended as follows:
 - (c) An attic level must be fully contained within the roof form. Attic levels must:
 - (i) Ensure the pitched roof form is the major visual roof element of the roof and must respond to the context.
- 7. (page 181) Part C2 Section 2.9, Control (f) is to be amended to state "Dormer windows and the like are to be less than 50% of the area of the roof elevation."
- 8. (page 416) A definition of the term "desired future character" is to be included as "Desired future character the character of a development that complies with the aspirations expressed within the objectives and provisions of the Waverley LEP and DCP 2012 and any other relevant plans adopted by Council." Wherever the term "desired future character" appears in the DCP, the wording "(refer to the definition contained at the back of this DCP)" is to be included.
- 9. The Director, Waverley Futures, ensures that footpath seating trading hours and clean-up time does not override any previously approved recycling conditions, and makes appropriate changes if necessary.
