COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council installs Yellow edge linemarking at the intersection of Clifton Lane at Busby Lane, Bronte at:

- a) 10m on the southern side of Clifton Lane, west of Busby Lane,
- b) 10m on the northern side of Clifton Lane, west of Busby Lane,
- c) 10m on the western side of Busby Lane, north of Clifton Lane,
- d) 10m on the western side of Busby Lane, south of Clifton Lane.

1. Executive Summary

Council has received representations from local residents requesting consideration be given to improving the sightlines and manoeuvrability for vehicles at the intersection of Busby Lane and Clifton Lane, Bronte. Council will need to exercise its delegated functions to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

Residents have reported that sightlines and manoeuvrability are restricted by vehicles parked in Clifton Lane within the statutory 10m setback from the intersection with Busby Lane. It is considered signs or lines should be installed to reinforce the 10m setback.

Council has also resolved to undertake a review of all signs in the Waverley LGA with an aim of minimising the number of signs that are installed. As part of the review process, it is proposed to trial the use of yellow edge linemarking in lieu of 'NO STOPPING' signs at intersections without other parking restrictions.

3. Technical Analysis

There are no signposted parking restrictions at the intersection of Clifton Lane and Busby Lane. A number of inspections have taken place during the day revealing vehicles are often parked in Clifton Lane within the 10m statutory setback from the intersection. Vehicles parked illegally at these locations reduce driver sight distances and manoeuvrability having regard to the narrow carriageway width in the both lanes. As compliance is an issue at this location, it is recommended that the legislative requirements be linemarked.

Legislative Requirements

Under the [NSW] *Road Rules 2008*:

"A driver must not stop on a road within 10 metres from the nearest point of an intersecting road at an intersection without traffic lights, unless the driver stops ... at a place on a length of road, or in an area, to which a parking control sign applies and the driver is permitted to stop at that place under these Rules ...". Therefore, vehicles parked at these locations may be infringed without the installation of additional signage or linemarking. However, the RMS's Technical Direction TDT 2002/12 *Stopping and Parking Restrictions at intersections and Crossings* addresses the installation of 'No Stopping' and 'No Parking' signs at intersections and states:

"It is not intended that signs be installed at all locations. Where signs are not installed the legislative restrictions will apply. Generally signposting of restrictions covered by legislative requirements is only required where there is adjoining signposting or compliance is an issue. However, signposting adjacent to children's crossings, pedestrian crossings and marked footcrossings should always occur. The relevant road authority is to determine where NO STOPPING and NO PARKING signs are to be erected.

Existing signs, with the exception of NO STANDING signs (see Technical Direction No 99/21), are not to be removed or replaced until required under maintenance. Where the post is required to be replaced, the sign should be relocated to the new location as specified in this *Technical Direction*."

Under the [NSW] *Road Rules 2008*:

"A driver must not stop at the side of a road marked with a continuous yellow edge line".

1. Executive Summary

Council has received an application from the builder/developer at No.57 Gardyne Street, Bronte for the installation of a construction zone across the site frontage. Council will need to exercise its delegated function to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

In accordance with standard practice in Waverley Council, it is proposed that the Construction Zone be signposted 'No Parking Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted' for the approved construction hours under the DA Consent. Council will then issue the applicant with a number of transferable permits to be used on their construction-related vehicles.

The Traffic Committee and Council generally only approve construction zones at the same length as the frontage, regardless of the location of driveways, for a minimum of thirteen weeks.

- 7. The temporary changes to parking restrictions in Leswell Street be removed and the original restrictions be reinstated as soon as possible following the completion of the excavation works at 344-354 Oxford Street.

1. Executive Summary

This report is for the Committee to consider:

- (a) The installation of a works/construction zone in Hegarty Lane for the final stage of bulk excavation works at the building site at 344-354 Oxford Street Lane, Bondi Junction and,
- (b) Temporary changes to parking restrictions in Leswell Street, west side, north of Hegarty Lane to facilitate trucks turn movements when departing the site. Council will need to exercise its delegated functions to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

A Construction Vehicle and Pedestrian Plan of Management (CVPPM) was approved by the Waverley Traffic Committee for the site at 344-354 Oxford Street, Bondi Junction (DA-101/2014) in 2015. A works/ construction zone was approved in principle for installation along the rear, Hegarty Lane boundary to facilitate the removal of the last of the excavated materials from the site having regard to excavation needing to take place up to the Hegarty Lane property boundary. The builder is now seeking approval for the zone on Hegarty Lane to remove the remaining spoil from the site.

3. Technical Analysis

A point has been reached in the excavation stage at the building site at 344-354 Oxford Street, Bondi Junction, corner of Vernon Street, that a temporary, earth ramp installed inside the site off Hegarty Lane providing truck and dog access into and out of the site is getting too steep for access by loaded trucks when exiting the site. As a result, approval is being sought by the builder to now stand trucks on Hegarty Lane with wheels partly inside the site and partly outside the site on Council's Hegarty Lane. Advice has been received from the excavation company that the wheels of their trucks when standing in the zone in Hegarty Lane will not encroach beyond the lip line of the Council's gutter. The full Hegarty Lane frontage of the site is the old driveway/layback serving the previous buildings.

In accordance with standard practice in Waverley Council, it is proposed that the Construction Zone be signposted 'No Parking Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted' for the approved construction hours under the DA Consent. Council will then issue the applicant with a number of transferable permits to be used on their construction-related vehicles. The zone if approved is to extend part way across the frontage of the property to the west at 332-342 Oxford Street. Evidence has been submitted to Council confirming the Owners Corporation have no objections to the zone extending part way across the boundary of that site.

In addition to the works/construction zone application, the builder is seeking a temporary removal of on street parking spaces on the western side of Leswell Street, north of Hegarty Lane to facilitate turn

movements by truck and dog trailers when travelling between Hegarty Lane and Grafton Street as per the approved CVPPM. At present, and it has been observed, some trucks with dog trailers are unable to exit Hegarty Lane and travel north in Leswell Street in one right turn movement. Some drivers need to execute one or more forward and reversing movements at the Hegarty Lane/ Leswell Street intersection to avoid impacting parked vehicles at the Leswell Street western kerb. The current parking restrictions in Leswell Street, west side north of Hegarty Lane are:

1/2P ticket 8am-12pm 2P ticket 12pm-7pm permit holders excepted area 22

In order for trucks to travel in accordance with the CVPPM approved route and make a right turn out of Hegarty Lane in one movement, vehicles parked kerbside on the western side of Leswell Street from Hegarty Lane to Grafton Street (some 4 vehicles) will need to be temporarily removed during the approved site work hours. Inspections reveal there is available parking for residents and others in close proximity to the temporarily lost parking spaces.

In this regard it is recommended a 23m long 'No Parking 7am–5pm Monday-Friday 8am–3pm Saturday' zone be installed on the western side of Leswell Street north of Hegarty Lane to facilitate turn movements during the final stages of excavation. **See attachment for details.**







Council will need to exercise its delegated function to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

An application has been received from Local Traffic Services on behalf of the builder, Growthbuilt, at 344-354 Oxford Street, Bondi Junction, corner of Vernon Street for a temporary, full closure of Vernon Street in the section between Oxford Street and Hegarty Lane/Rowe Lane and a closure of a section of the north side, kerb side lane on Oxford Street either side of Vernon Street to facilitate the installation of a tower crane. 

That Council installs a 5.50 m long "P DISABILITY ONLY" parking zone outside 84 Ruthven Street, Bondi Junction.

1. Executive Summary

Council has received representations from the resident of 84 Ruthven Street, Bondi Junction requesting Council give consideration to the installation of a 'P Disability Only' zone to improve parking and access to the premises. This report recommends the installation of the zone. Council will need to exercise its delegated functions to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

At the Waverley Traffic Committee meeting held on 10 November 2005, the issue of installing 'P Disability Only' parking was discussed. Subsequently, at the Council meeting held on 13 December 2005, it was resolved:

That the following guidelines for assessing applications for a mobility parking space on a residential street be adopted:

- 1. Together with proof of their mobility-parking permit, applicants for a mobility parking space must have a vehicle registered to their address. They do not need to be the driver of the vehicle.
- 2. Applicants who have access to off-street parking will not be entitled to a mobility parking space.
- 3. At least three site visits will be carried out of a morning and evening for each application. These site visits will also be carried out annually. The level of parking within 50m either side of the property must be at or above 85% capacity on each separate occasion.
- 4. Letters will be sent to residents annually to determine if the mobility parking space is still required. Residents will also be requested to again provide proof of current registration and their mobility-parking permit.

3. Technical Analysis

Ruthven Street is a local road that runs in a north-south direction between Birrell Street and Oxford Street, Bondi Junction. Parking in Ruthven Street is restricted to '2P 8am-6pm Mon-Sat Permit Holders Excepted Area 22'. The applicant has access to off-street parking but due to a limited garage width (2.5m), he has requested that consideration be given to allocation of a disabled parking space outside the property. The garage will be utilised for the parking of a second vehicle. A disabled parking zone, if approved, will need to extend partly across the adjoining property at 80 Ruthven Street. The applicant has provided a support letter from both neighbours immediately to the north and south raising no objections to the proposed zone. It is recommended that a space be provided to the north of the driveway to 84 Ruthven Street and be 5.5m long as per AS 2890.5-1993 Clause 4.5.2.

2. Introduction/Background

The attached Traffic Management Plan (TMP) has been prepared to address traffic and transport issues. It is the second Bondi BeachFest event. The Outdoor & Flagship Events team are working closely with the event organiser to approve the event once again under DA-282/2015 consent conditions to hold a public temporary event in Bondi Park & Beach. Gates will open to the public at 15:45 and the event concludes by 23:00. It is a slow and steady ingress with patrons arriving from 15.00 until the last act at 21:00.

Event tickets have been capped at 7500 to limit the impact on residents and minimise disruption to transport in the area. The transport arrangements for this event will be similar to last year's event- see

"Technical Analysis" section for changes. There are no records of Council receiving formal complaints relating to the 2015 event.

This event does not require road closures unless directed by NSW Police as part of a contingency plan.

This event is to be heavily promoted as a public transport event with the STA engaged at the conclusion of the event to run a shuttle bus service from Bondi Beach to Bondi Junction.

This is a Class 2 Special Event under the RMS's *Guide to Traffic and Transport Management for Special Events*. The Traffic Committee is required to make recommendations to Council regarding the traffic management aspects of the event, advising Council on conditions to set for the use of road space. 




SHUTTLE BUS SCHEDULE


















ATTACHMENT Portable Variable Message Signs [VMS]

We recommend 2 VMS are used on each key approach of Campbell Pde. and one VMS for patron crowd direction during egress.


The two VMS will be facing main traffic streams NB and SB and serve the purpose of advance advertising as well as critical messages during event mode – mainly orientated to safety warning for road users regarding increased pedestrian activity and general directions for drop-off and pick-up.

The third VMS will be positioned within the event site perimeter and supplemented by crowd controls barriers to achieve separation of the egress crowd into:

- 1. Patrons wishing to use the Free Charter Bus service to Bondi Junction,
- 2. Patrons wishing to leave on foot and either use a taxi and continue on foot.
