TC/C STATE ELECTORATE OF COOGEE

TC/C.01/16.10 Gould Street, North Bondi - Installation of 'P Disability Only' Zone (A02/0273-02)

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council installs a 5.5 m long "P DISABILITY ONLY" parking zone on the Gould Street frontage of 115 O'Donnell Street, North Bondi adjacent to and on the southern side of the driveway to the property.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted.

TC/C.02/16.10 508 Bronte Road, Bronte - Works/ Construction Zone in Calga Place/Bronte Cutting (A03/2514-04)

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That:

1. Council Installs 12m of "No Parking 7am-5pm Monday-Friday; 8am-3pm Saturday- Authorised Council Vehicles Excepted" in parking spaces 111 and 112 in the Calga Place/ Bronte Cutting car park at the rear of 508 Bronte Road.
2. Council delegates authority to the Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, to:
 - Extend the duration of zone as necessary.
 - Audit and cancel this approval without notice or refund.
3. There being no blockage of access to through traffic in the Calga Place/Bronte Cutting Carpark other than for short periods of time when manoeuvring vehicles into and out of the zone.
4. Council delegates authority to the Executive Manager, Creating Waverley to temporarily remove parking for the public and install an appropriately signposted zone on the opposite/eastern side of Calga Place if it is found trucks standing in the works zone restrict the free and safe flow of traffic on Calga Place.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted subject to the following amendments:

1. The words 'until 30 November 2016' be added to end of Clause 1.
2. The addition of the following clause:

“Maximum truck size permitted in the Bronte Cutting be no more than 7m overall length.”

TC/V STATE ELECTORATE OF VAUCLUSE

TC/V.01/16.10 14 Consett Avenue, Bondi Beach - Works/Construction Zone (A03/2514-04)

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That :

1. Council installs a 9m long, “No Parking 7am-5pm Mon-Fri; 8am-3pm Sat - Authorised Council Vehicles Excepted” zone across the frontage of No.14 Consett Avenue, Bondi Beach
2. Council delegates authority to the Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, to:
 - Extend the duration of zone as necessary.
 - Audit and cancel this approval without notice or refund.
3. There be no blockage of access to through traffic and to or from the adjacent and opposite on-street and off-street car parking spaces other than for short periods of time when manoeuvring vehicles into and out of the zone.
4. Council temporarily removes the existing post with parking control signs from outside the property and reinstates it following the removal of the works zone.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted.

TC/V.02/16.10 Isabel Avenue, Vaucluse - Works/Construction Zone (A03/2514-04)

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

1. Installs a zone of “No Parking 7am–5 pm Mon-Fri” Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted” outside 4-6 Isabel Avenue, Vaucluse commencing at the prolongation of the western boundary and terminating 19m to the east for a period of 13 weeks.
2. Will only consider reducing “Construction Zone” lengths on the grounds of safety.
3. Installs a zone of “No Stopping 7am-5pm Mon-Fri” on the southern side of Isabel Avenue outside Kimberley Reserve commencing on the western side of the driveway to 3 Isabel Avenue for a

distance of 12m to the west to cater for the swept wheel path of trucks entering and exiting 4-6 Isabel Avenue.

4. Delegates authority to the Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, to extend the duration and location of the zones on both sides of Isabel Avenue if and when necessary.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted subject to the following amendments:

1. Clause 1 to be amended to read as follows:

“Installs a “No Parking 7am–4 pm Mon-Fri Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted” zone outside 4-6 Isabel Avenue, Vauclose as agreed with the applicant commencing at the prolongation of the western boundary and terminating 19m to the east for a period of 13 weeks, noting that the approved Construction Vehicle and Pedestrian Plan of Management (CVPPM) indicates there will be no work on Saturdays.”

2. The “No Stopping 7am-5pm Mon-Fri” in Clause 3 be amended to “No Stopping 7am-4pm Mon-Fri”.

3. The addition of the following clause:

“To improve vehicle turning movement at the corner of Craig Avenue and Diamond Bay Road, especially for trucks from subject site, installs ‘No Stopping’ signs on the South Western corner.”
