Apologies

Declarations of Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary Interests

The Chair called for declarations of interest and the following were received:

0.1 Sgt Luke Barrett declared a less than significant non pecuniary interest in Item TC/V.04/17.10 – Hall Street, Bondi Beach - Installation of 'Keep Clear' Pavement Marking, and informed the meeting that this item was referred to the Traffic Committee by NSW Police.

Adoption of previous Minutes by Council - 28 September 2017

The recommendations contained in Part 1 - Matters Proposing That Council Exercise Its Delegated Functions - of the Minutes of the Waverley Traffic Committee meeting held on 28 September 2017 were adopted by Council at its meeting on 10 October 2017, with the following changes:

1. TC/V.02/17.09 – Bon Accord Avenue, Bondi Junction - Introduction of Resident Parking Restrictions

Council resolved not to adopt the recommendation of the Traffic Committee Meeting, and made the following decision:

'That Council:

- 1. Installs '2P 8 am–6 pm Mon-Sat Permit Holders Excepted Area 26' restrictions along Bon Accord Avenue.
- 2. Delegates authority to the Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, to extend the evening restrictions from 6 pm to 10 pm should the majority of residents request such an extension at a future time.'
- 2. TC/V.08/17.09 Wairoa Avenue, North Bondi 'P Motorbikes Only'.

Council resolved not to adopt the recommendation of the Traffic Committee Meeting, and made the following decision:

'That Council not approves the installation of motorbike parking between 19 Wairoa Avenue and 8– 12 Frederick Street.'

TC/C STATE ELECTORATE OF COOGEE

TC/C.01/17.10 Multiple Streets - 'P Disability Only' Zone (A02/0273-02)

This matter was mistakenly placed in the State Electorate of Coogee. This item was considered under the State Electorate of Vaucluse.

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

- 1. Installs a 6.5 m long 'P Disability Only' zone outside 72 O'Donnell Street, North Bondi.
- 2. Removes the existing 'P Disability Only' zone outside 29 Roe Street, North Bondi.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted.

TC/C.02/17.10 Grafton Street, Bondi Junction - New Bus Zones and Alterations to Existing Parking Restrictions (A02/0225-02)

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

- 1. Installs a 60 metre long "Bus Zone" immediately east of the existing P5 minute parking zone on the northern side of Grafton Street, Bondi Junction between Newland Street and Grosvenor Street.
- 2. Removes the existing painted kerb blisters located within and at the eastern end of the proposed bus zone.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted.

TC/V STATE ELECTORATE OF VAUCLUSE

TC/V.01/17.10 Curlewis Street, Bondi Beach - Construction Zone (A03/2514-04)

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That:

- 1. Council installs a 12 m long 'No Parking 7 am–5 pm Monday–Friday 8 am–3 pm Saturday Authorised Council Vehicles Excepted' zone across the frontage of 86 Curlewis Street, Bond Beach.
- 2. There be no blockage to through traffic on Curlewis Street other than for short periods of time when manoeuvring vehicles into and out of the Construction Zone.
- 3. Council delegates authority to the Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, to extend the length and duration of, or remove the construction zone as necessary.

WTC RECOMMENDATION (UNANIMOUS SUPPORT):

That the Council Officer's Proposal be adopted.

TC/V.02/17.10 Ocean Street North, Bondi - Changes to Parking Restrictions (A02/0637-02) COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

- Changes the existing 'P5 minute: 8am-6pm Mon-Fri; No Parking: 6pm-10pm Mon-Fri 8am-10pm Sat-Sun Wedding & Funeral Vehicles Excepted' to 'P5 minute: 7:30am-6pm Mon-Fri; No Parking 6pm-10pm Mon-Fri 8am-10pm Sat-Sun Wedding & Funeral Vehicles Excepted' outside 34A Ocean Street North, Bondi.
- 2. Not approve any extension to the length of the existing drop off/pick up zone outside 34A Ocean Street North, Bondi.

TC/V.03/17.10 Military Road, Vaucluse - Temporary Relocation of Bus Zone (A02/0225-02) COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

- 1. Approves the temporarily relocation of existing bus stop No. 203025 to a new location, commencing at the power pole outside No. 376 Military Road for a distance of 24m to the east and terminating outside No. 372 Military Road, as shown in Figure 2 in the report subject to the installation of an approved works/construction zone being installed outside the site.
- 2. Notifies affected residents of the temporary changes prior to implementation.
- 3. Arranges with Sydney Buses to reinstate the bus zone to its original location as soon as practicable following completion of the building works.

- 1. The Council Officer's Proposal not be adopted.
- 2. The item be deferred to the November Traffic Committee to allow for further discussions to occur between Sydney Buses, the applicant and Councils officers regarding the relocation of the bus zone on the Military Road frontage of 695 Old South head Road, Vaucluse.
