 - Notify local residents and businesses seven days prior to the event; and
 - Only use RMS-accredited Traffic Controllers.
- 4. The Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, and their representative(s) are delegated authority to:
 - Inspect the TMP;
 - Audit the implementation of the TMP; and
 - Cancel this approval, without notice or refund.

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

- 1. Installs 367 m of yellow No Stopping line on the southern side of Trafalgar Street commencing at the angle parking area to the west and terminating at the existing 'No Stopping'/'No Parking' sign on Calga Street 10 m from the intersection of Trafalgar Street.
- 2. Installs 20 m of yellow No Stopping line on the northern side of Trafalgar Street commencing 10 m from the intersection of Calga Street and concluding on Calga Street 10 m from the intersection of Trafalgar Street.
- 3. Removes the existing 'No Stopping' arrow left sign and post located on the southern side of Trafalgar Street before Calga Avenue.

1. Executive Summary

Council has received numerous complaints regarding vehicles parking on the roadway on the non, kerb and guttered, southern side of Trafalgar Street adjacent to Waverley Cemetery. In order to reduce the incidence of illegal parking, it is proposed to install a yellow painted edge line to effect No Stopping. Council will need to exercise its delegated functions to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

Due to its proximity to Bronte Beach and Calga Reserve, Trafalgar Street is frequently used as a de facto parking area. The parking on Trafalgar Street occurs both behind/off to the side of the carriageway within the road reserve area and on street parallel to the road alignment.

3. Technical Analysis

Trafalgar Street is a local road within the road hierarchy and has a carriageway width of 6.4 m. Parking is permitted on the northern (residential) side of the street. When vehicles park illegally on the southern side, it reduces the effective width of the carriageway to 2.2 m. This is insufficient for a fire truck which is 2.5 m wide.

This parking is made illegal as vehicles are effectively parking within 3m of another vehicle, obstructing the through access.

This proposal is intended to prevent vehicles from parking parallel on the carriageway. Council is currently investigating options to discourage/prevent parking on the grassed road reserve area between the carriageway and the Waverley Cemetery northern boundary fence.

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

1. Installs a 15 m of 'No Parking 7am–5pm Monday-Friday 8am–3pm Saturday Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted' on Murray Street, Bronte, adjacent to the frontage of 30A Murray Street.




Figure 2. Proposed Construction Zone and relocation of bus zone

2. Relocates bus stop No. 202453 27.6 m to the east and provides a 31.8 m bus zone, to a location adjacent to 38 Murray Street, as shown in Figure 2.

1. Executive Summary

This report is for the Committee to consider the installation of a works/construction zone adjacent to 30A Murray Street, Bronte, and for the temporary relocation of a bus zone required to make way for the installation of the works /construction zone. Council will be required to exercise its delegated function to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

To provide construction vehicle access to 30A Murray Street, and limit parking in the vicinity, a works/construction zone will be required. The installation of the construction zone will require the temporary relocation of the bus zone which currently utilises the proposed works/construction zone area.

The bus zone at 30A Murray Street is the closest available stop to the Sydney Clinic Private Hospital at 22-24 Murray Street to the west and is regularly used. With the bus zone positioned at the bottom of a gully, access to the nearest bus stops requires an uphill walk of 150 m to the east or 216 m to the west. Given the high usage of the stop and the surrounding topography, it is considered the bus stop needs to remain in operation and be close by.

3. Technical Analysis

The location specified has a straight alignment and relatively gentle slope (5.7%) immediately adjacent to the existing bus service. Given the primarily residential nature of Murray Street, it is not possible to relocate this stop without positioning it adjacent to a residential property.



Figure 1. Existing Bus Zone in vicinity of 30A Murray Street, Bronte.

This relocation of the bus zone proposed to the eats will result in the loss of 5 unrestricted on street parking spaces for the duration of the construction activity. The works at 30A Murray Street on the Murray Street frontage are relatively minor in nature with the construction only of a double garage and driveway and will very likely be completed within the 13 weeks allocated for the construction zone.

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That:

- 1. Council removes the '1/2P Ticket 8am–12 noon, 2P Ticket 12noon–9pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 22' on the eastern side of Denison Street between Oxford Street and Ebley Street, Bondi Junction, and reinstates the '1/2P Ticket 8am–12 noon, 2P Ticket 12noon–9pm.'
- 2. Officers in the Customer First sub-program section notify affected businesses and residents of the above changes to parking restrictions and adjust the signs accordingly.

1. Executive Summary

Complaints have been received at Council from business operators informing of a reduction in parking availability for their customers and others on the eastern side of Denison Street between Oxford Street and Ebley Street following changes to parking restrictions allowing residents with parking permits to park unrestricted. The purpose of the report is to seek approval to the removal of the resident parking exemptions in place on the above section of roadway. Council will need to exercise its delegated functions to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

Changes were made to parking restrictions in Denison Street on the eastern side between Oxford Street and Ebley Street in May 2015 following a review of the operation of parking meters in Bondi junction area. Following the review, resident parking restrictions were introduced directly outside the commercial zoned premises. Business operators are advising parking for their customers and others is now very difficult with there being a high demand for parking and reduced turnover in the general vicinity.

3. Technical Analysis

Inspections and surveys of on-street parking have revealed that a significant proportion of vehicles parked on the above section of roadway are vehicles displaying resident parking permits with many of them parked for extended periods. The inspections also revealed that at the busy morning and evening peaks times, there was a high demand for street parking with drivers double parking and parking in "No Stopping" zones. Council in the past has not supported the introduction of resident parking outside commercial premises in the Bondi Junction area so as to provide a balance of parking supply. Since introducing resident

parking to the eastern side of Denison Street, the supply of parking for the customers of business has reduced. It is considered the resident parking restrictions should be removed for the following reasons:

- To reinstate the quantum of parking for business related vehicles that was in place prior to introduction of resident parking.
- It sets an undesirable precedent which may result in residents requesting other streets in the Bondi Junction CBD area be provided with similar parking.

4. Financial Information for Council's Consideration

If changes to signs and/or linemarking are approved, Council will supply and install the signs and/or linemarking, to be funded from existing budgets.

That Council approves the traffic and transport arrangements for the Sculpture by the Sea 2016 Special Event as per the attached Transport Management Plan, subject to the following conditions:

1. Council shall:

- (a) Forward the Transport Management Plan to the RMS for TfNSW approval of the temporary closures and implementation of one-way movements.
- (b) Undertake the Traffic Control for the event.
- (c) Develop and implement a Communications Strategy, in conjunction with the Event Organiser, to notify the local residents of the changes to traffic conditions.

2. The Event Organiser shall:

- (a) Provide an Event Management Plan to Council's events team for approval at least 4 weeks prior to the event including public liability insurance for the event.
- (b) Apply for cranes permit.
- 3. The Executive Manager, Creating Waverley, and the Executive Manager, Customer First, and their representative(s), are delegated authority to:
 - (a) Inspect the TMP.
 - (b) Audit the implementation of the TMP.
 - (c) Cancel this approval, without notice or refund.

1. Executive Summary

Sculpture by the Sea 2016, now in its 20th year, is a free sculpture exhibition held between Marks Park and Tamarama Park along the Coastal Walk. The exhibitions is planned to be held between Thursday, 20 October and Sunday, 6 November 2016. The event is mounted by the not-for-profit Sculpture by the Sea (referred to in this report as the Event Organiser). To manage the impact of the event on local roads and resident amenity, Council implements the Traffic Management Plan submitted for approval. This report

details the traffic management aspects of the event. Council will need to exercise its delegated functions to implement the proposal.

2. Introduction/Background

Council's Creating Waverley Division has developed the attached Transport Management Plan (TMP) in consultation with the Event Organiser and Council's Outdoor and Flagship Events Team. In line with the 2015 event, Council will engage a contractor to implement the TMP.

Last year after many meetings and consultations, stakeholders agreed and implement further strategies to manage safety and resident issues being experienced in Bronte Marine Drive around Tamarama Park which involved:

- 1. The creation of a dedicated zone on Campbell Parade for private coaches and chartered buses, associated communications plan and signage as shown in *Figure 1* attached to the report,
- 2. The Event Organisers splitting their education program sites between Tamarama Park and Marks Part to alleviate the pressure of school buses/coaches requiring drop off and pick up access to Tamarama Park.

After the 2015 exhibition, stakeholders agreed that this these additional strategies to manage coach and bus access in and around Marks and Tamarama Park had worked well despite the occasional 'rogue' private bus operators doing the wrong thing and parking in Tamarama Marine Drive. The event organisers had however received feedback from some schools catering for young children attending the 2 Programs held in Tamarama Park (1 in morning, 1 in afternoon) held to cater to this age group. They felt that the walk to and from the designated Campbell Parade drop-off/pick-up area was too much for this age group.

It was also noted that one way couplet at the intersection of Gaerloch Avenue and Dellview Street, implemented for the last 3 years, had been working well with no reported incidents. To bed in this change, this couplet was manned by approved traffic controllers at weekends. Stakeholders agreed that there was no further need for this one way couplet at the Gaerloch Avenue/Dellview Street intersection but would continue at the Fletcher Street/Dellview Street end.

2016 TMP Changes to address 2015 feedback

The following changes have been made to the 2015 approved TMP (highlighted in the attached TMP).

Pacific Avenue

The creation of a 'No parking Authorised Vehicles Excepted' between 9.30am and 5.30pm on the western side as shown in Figure 2 attached to the report.

Council will provide the Event Organiser with the following permits for use on Pacific Avenue.

- 2 weekday permits for use Monday to Fridays during the exhibition period.
 This allows for a maximum of 1 school chartered buses/coaches to park in this zone at any one time for drop up and pick up. The Event Organiser will be responsible for meeting the registered chartered school buses/coach groups and issuing the permit to the vehicle driver for display whilst they are standing in the area.
- 2. 5 x weekend permits valid for each exhibition weekend for use by Hyundai courtesy vehicles. This replaces the zone previously provided in Tamarama Marine Drive south of Sydney Buses Bus Stop

One way couplet- Gaerloch Avenue

Approved traffic controllers will be in place at the Fletcher Street/Dellview Street intersection as in previous years, but not at the Gaerloch Avenue/Dellview Street intersection.

Road Closure- Resident Access Only - Trial

Council will trial a closure of the following roads, with signs only between 7.30am-6.30pm for the duration of the event with local resident access only:

- o Birrell Street, east of Tamarama Street, and
- Darling Street, east of Alfred Street.

Trial of One-Way – Turner Street – Trial

Council will trial a one-way westbound direction in Turner Street for the duration of the event.

The NSW Police Force has previously indicated that this is a Class 2 Special Event, with road closures, under the RMS's *Guide to Traffic and Transport Management for Special Events*. The Traffic Committee is required to make recommendations to Council regarding the traffic management aspects of the event, advising Council on conditions to set for the use of road space.

TfNSW will need to approve temporary closures and one-way movements and the Transport Management Plan will be forwarded to the RMS for their consideration. Once all approvals and conditions have been met, staff from the RMS and Council's Executive Manager, Creating Waverley can sign the Traffic Management Plan to authorise implementation.

3. Technical Analysis

- the venue at no charge,
- additional waste collections,
- parking facilities,
- park restoration,
- electricity,


- additional Ranger and Parks staff hours,

- an annual community grant


All of these costs are absorbed by existing budgets of relevant Divisions, at the expense of competing demands.

INTRODUCTION

Sculpture by the Sea (referred to as the Event), now in its 20th year, is a free outdoor sculpture exhibition along Waverley's Coastal Walk between Marks Park and Tamarama Park. This year the event will be held from 20 October to 6 November 2016. The event is organiser by the not-for-profit entity Sculpture by the Sea (referred to as the Event Organiser).

This *Transport Management Plan (TMP)* is prepared by Waverley Council (referred to as Council) to manage the impact of the Sculpture by the Sea event on local roads, resident amenity and pedestrian safety. It has been prepared by Waverley Council's Professional Engineer, Mr Sam Samadian, in consultation with Council's Outdoor and Flagship Events Unit.

Any changes made to the approved 2015 TMP resulting from feedback from all stakeholders including Sydney Buses and RMS have been highlighted in yellow in the document.

This *TMP* will remain in Draft format, until it has been approved by Council. Any conditions placed on this *TMP* by Council will be incorporated in the Final version.

Waverley Council will engage a contractor to undertake the traffic management of The Event.

Objectives

The objectives of this *TMP* are to:

- comply with requirements of Occupational Health & Safety Act 2000,
- manage reduced capacity of local road system
- minimise traffic impact on non-event community & emergency services

Scope

This *TMP* covers the traffic and transport requirements of The Event, including:

Marks Park bump-in	10 October to 19 October 2016,
Tamarama Park bump-in	17 October to 19 October 2016,
Coastal Walk bump-in	12 October to 19 October 2016,
Sculpture by the Sea event	20 October to 6 November 2016,
Marks Park bump-out	7 November to 11 November 2016,
Tamarama Park bump-out	7 November to 11 November 2016,
Coastal Walk bump-out	7 November to 11 November 2016.

Sculpture by the Sea 2016

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Any further traffic management measures will need to be provided by The Event Organiser. This includes, but is not limited to, traffic control for crane lifts associated with the bump-in / bump-out periods. Additional approvals will be required.

ADMINISTRATION

Approvals

Waverley Traffic Committee

The Local Area Traffic Committee is required to make recommendations to Council regarding the traffic management aspects of The Event, advising Council on conditions to set for the use of road space.

Waverley Council

Council will consider the recommendations of the Traffic Committee and assess all other impacts on the surrounding environment before issuing a Schedule of Conditions. It is anticipated that this *TMP* and the committee's recommendations will be considered by Council at the same meeting that it considers all other aspects of The Event.

Separate approval is required from Council's Divisional Manager Technical Services for additional traffic control. The use of cranes will require additional permits.

Transport Management Centre (TMC)

This is classified as a Type 2 Special Event, in accordance with the RMS's *Guide to Traffic and Transport Management for Special Events*.

The TMC will need to approve the temporary traffic changes. This *TMP*, together with the RMS's standard TMP, will be forwarded for their consideration. Once all approvals have been received and all conditions have been met, Council's Executive Manager, Creating Waverley can issue a signed copy of this *TMP* for implementation.

The event organiser in conjunction with Sydney Buses are to discuss the implementation of clearways on weekends along Bondi Road with the TMC.

Gazetted Speed Limits will not be changed for this event.

NSW Police Force

This *TMP* has been provided to the Eastern Suburbs Local Area Command, as part of the membership to the Local Area Traffic Committee.

The Event Organiser is required to obtain Police approval to hold the event.

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Notifications

Event notifications, prepared in consultation with Council's Communications Team and the Event Organiser, will be distributed via a letter-box drop in the weeks leading up to the Event. Copies of the residents' notification letters and their distribution maps have been provided in *Appendix* 1. .

Sydney Buses, Local Fire Brigades (Randwick, Woollahra & Bondi Fire Stations) and NSW Ambulance Service are to be notified with a copy of this *TMP* via fax before 1 October 2016.

Bump-Out

Tamarama Park

RMS-accredited Traffic Controllers will control traffic in Tamarama Marine Drive and Pacific Avenue, for trucks to cross into Tamarama Park.

Extraordinary Traffic Control

Any additional traffic control will need to be provided by The Event Organiser and this will require separate permits and approval by the Divisional Manager Technical Services. This includes, but is not limited to, traffic control for crane lifts.

Traffic Control Plans

Traffic Control Plans will be prepared, in accordance with Australian Standard AS1742.3 MUTCD: Part 3 – Traffic Control at Work Sites and the RMS's Traffic Control at Work Sites manual, by Council officers once Council has approved this TMP.

Council will engage a contractor to implement the Traffic Control Plans in the manner outlined in Appendix 3.

PARKING

To assist the Event Organiser with the organisation required to stage the event whilst minimising the impact on local residents, limited parking passes will be provided in designated areas and additional temporary permit/coach areas parking zones will be created as detailed below.

Parking Permits

The Event Organiser will be provided with a range of Council authorised parking permits over the exhibition period, in order to provide parking for:

- Set up and de rig crew (including artists)
- Staff and Volunteers,
- · VIPs and Media Personnel.

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The permits will be clearly identify as Council issued permits for the purpose of the Exhibition and will have the date(s) and specific areas the permit is valid.

Council will provide all permits to the Event Organiser prior to bump-in of the event. The Event Organiser will be responsible for the management of distributing:

- Day only permits Valid for the day as indicated on the permit and able to be transferred to different vehicles as required during the applicable permit's date. No vehicle registration included.
- Council permitted vehicle permits with relevant vehicle registration number and valid for dates stated on permit. Registration included on permit.

Any additional exhibition-related vehicles requiring parking will need to utilise the existing on-street parking in the area.

Any vehicle parked in Council's reserves without a permit and/or contrary to the [NSW] *Road Rules 2008* will be infringed by Council's Parking Services Division.

SPECTATORS

It is estimated that up to 500,000 spectators will attend the Event. While a significant number of these are expected on weekends, a large number of school and private tour groups are expected during weekdays.






Figure 2 - Pick-up in Marks Park

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That:

- 1. No objections be raised to the alteration to the shape of the existing kerb blister adjacent outside 30 Murray Street, Bronte, as shown in concept in the report to accommodate bus movements to STA bus stop No.202453.
- 2. Detailed drawings of the changes to the island and associated adjustments to line marking be referred back to a future meeting of the Traffic Committee.

1. Executive Summary

This item is submitted to the Committee for engineering advice on the possible alteration of a kerb blister adjacent to 30 Murray Street, Bronte. Council does not need to exercise its delegated functions.

2. Introduction/Background

The kerb side blister located on the northern side of Murray Street outside No. 30 was installed in 1994 after consideration by the Murray Street working party, the Waverly Traffic Committee and Council. It forms part of a Local Area Traffic Management (LATM) scheme on Murray Street. This is one of four kerb blisters installed on the approach/departure to the low point on Murray Street.

The purpose of the blister is to narrow the carriageway width and effect a reduction of vehicle speeds on Murray Street and provide enhanced delineation for motorists. The blister islands form the end points of an E1 edgeline delineation of the carriageway through the low point of Murray Street.

3. Technical Analysis

The island at 30 Murray Street is semi-circular in shape and is located between the driveway access of No. 28 and No. 30 Murray Street. The distance between the wings of the driveways is 6 m. The blister reduces the width of the travel lane to 3.55 m at this point.

In order to access the bus stop outside 30A Murray Street, 12.5 m-long STA buses require 24 m to draw in parallel to the kerb. It should be noted that this distance is measured from an obstruction, such as a parked vehicle, which is considered to be 2.1 m from the face of the kerb.

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In this instance the blister extends 3.2 m out from the face of kerb requiring buses to commence the draw in movement further into the carriageway. This results in buses accessing the stop at an angle resulting in the tail of the vehicle protruding and creating a gap between the kerb and the entry/exit to the bus.

The proposal is to reduce the width of the island to 2.1 m (measured from the face of kerb) which will improve access to the bus stop and allow buses to draw in effectively. A concept of the altered shape of the blister is shown below.

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


Figure 2. Proposed alteration to kerb blister
